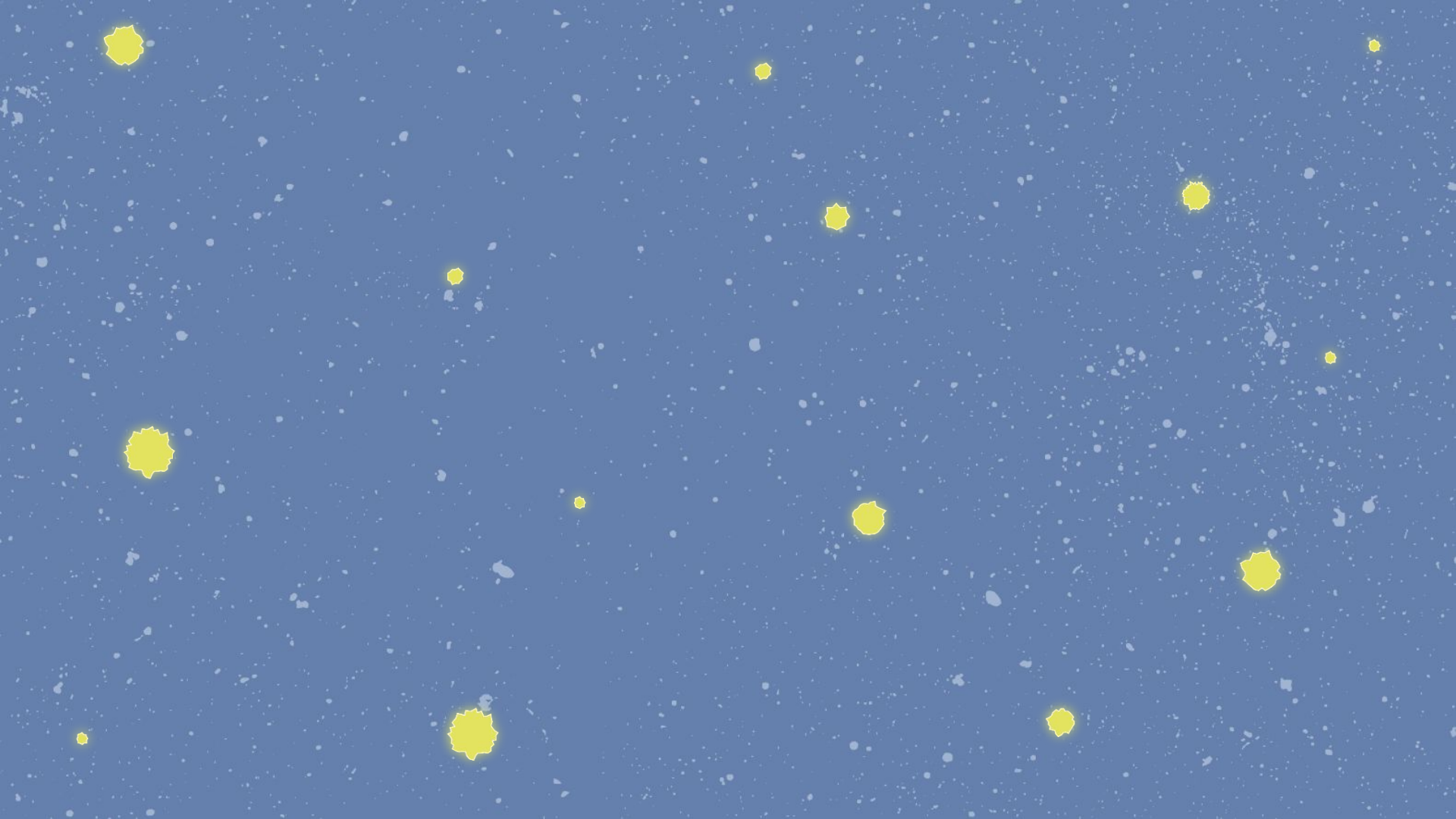

It was born from the desire to strengthen networks of care, creation, and recording of the stories that shape the anti-racist struggle in Brazil.

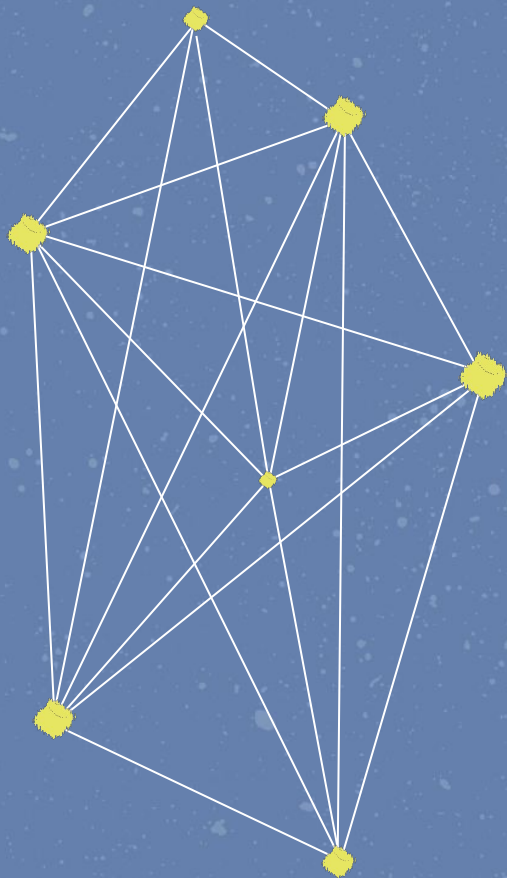


Why talk about constellations?

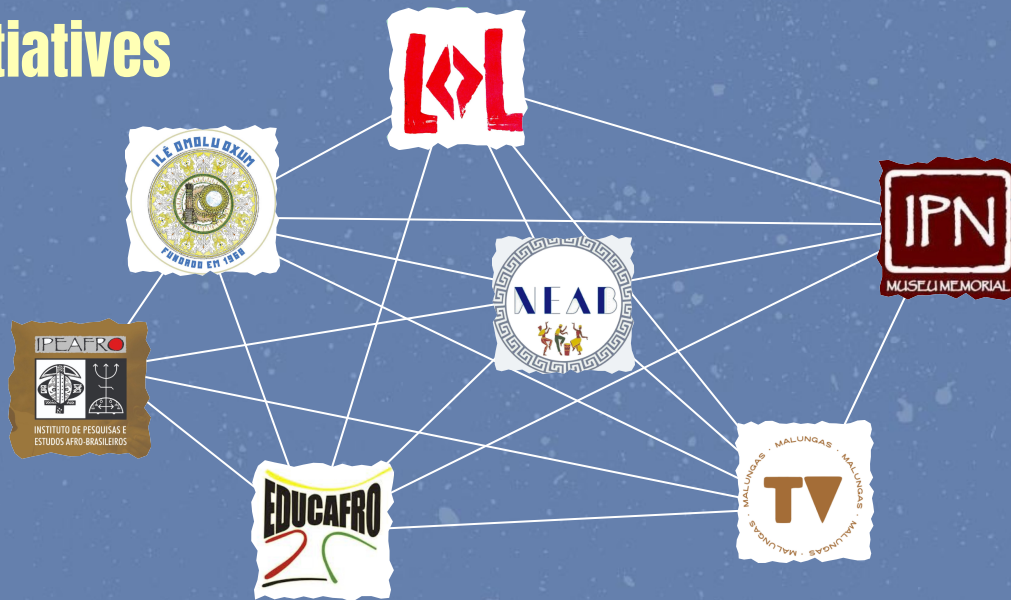
What are Black Memory Constellations?
